KSSB, working in concert with the State Board of Education and the Unified Government/Wyandotte County Public Health Department, announces our school reopening plan for the 2020-2021 School Year:

- **Aug 10th-14th and Aug 17th-21st:** Professional Development for Teachers/Staff
- **August 24th:** Remote learning for all students begins
- **September 8th:** Enrollment Day*
- **September 9th:** On-site classes begin *

**Enrollment Day and On-Site learning are tentative dates, depending on Wyandotte County Public Health Department orders.*

Please Note:

- Enrollment forms will be mailed to parents and can be returned by mail or brought on Enrollment Day.
- Students will be provided with all technology necessary to access remote learning activities prior to August 24th.
- Students will receive a remote learning schedule that includes names of teachers, classes, and start/end times.
- Our goal is to return students to school as soon as possible, but we also want students to become proficient accessing learning online.
- Parents will receive KSSB's Reopening Guide that explains our safety protocols and procedures for keeping students safe when on-site learning returns.
- KSSB's contract Social Worker, Ronald Wilson, will be contacting families to determine if there are needs that we can assist with, prior to on-site learning.
- KSSB will be in contact with your child's local school district, and we will coordinate services until on-site learning begins.

Field Services:

- KSSB's Field Services team will be available to meet the needs of local school and students starting **August 24th**. Services will be provided both remotely and on-site, working in coordination with Local Education Agencies and County Health Departments.
