

# Vision Symposium

## On-Line Etiquette Protocols

#### 1. Log in to the Symposium five to ten minutes before the start time. Do not be late!

- Logging in early gives you time to say hello to and introduce yourself to the presenter.
- Please be sure to have your name displayed (not a phone number or nickname).
  - To change your name, hover over your name and select "more", then click on the rename option.

### 2. Mute your audio whenever you are not speaking.

- This helps avoid unwanted background noises that can distract other participants.
  - NOTE: NEVER push the "HOLD" button if joining from a phone. This plays music over the line, which causes significant problems for the meeting.

### 3. Be an active participant.

- Respond to requests for comments or questions in the chat. Can also use the raise hand feature.
  - Simply raise your virtual hand by clicking on the hand picture where your box is.
- Appropriately notify the presenter that you have a question or comment by raising hand.
- In the chat, be sure Everyone is selected, unless you need to send a Private message.
- Keep your camera on when joining sessions, and until the presenter starts talking.
- Only turn off the camera when the presenter starts session; turn back on when session is over.

### 5. Be respectful.

- The Symposium sessions will allow a publicly-visible chat box.
- Please no inside jokes, comments, links not applicable, disturbing content, etc.
- Please keep your contributions helpful and considerate of the host and other participants.
- Don't be late when rejoining from breaks, lunch, etc.

### 6. Provide feedback after the event to help us plan for future events.

- You will receive a Google Form Survey from the Symposium Committee. You must complete
  this as part of attending the event.
- Feedback helps improve the presentations by letting presenters know what worked well and what didn't. Sharing this in the chat is appreciated as well.
  - Examples of good feedback are:
    - Were there audio problems? Difficulty reading slide content?
    - What was the most interesting thing you learned?

#### 7. Additional Information.

- As stated above, log on early to EACH session, not just at the beginning.
- Dress appropriately! No pajamas.
- While your camera is on; no eating, moving around, etc.
- Don't have just your forehead showing!! Please check the camera beforehand.
- Keep the agenda close by during the event so you are aware of time.
- As stated above, log on early to EACH session, not just at the beginning.
- Breakout rooms with people outside of KSSB. Please get to know other Kansas Professionals.
- You will not be able to share your screen during the Symposium.
